

In the contemporary times forestry sector is at the crossroads. It has assumed centre stage with positioning of not only non tangible benefits like timber, fuelwood, fodder, medicinal plants etc. but also other significant intangibles like clean air, water, soil protection, aesthetics, temperature regulation etc. In the current Corona pandemic times, the civil society has appreciated these life-sustaining values of wilderness.

Forestry, in a holistic view, is an integration of various disciplines relying on scientific principles and traditional wisdom. The Directorate of Forest Education's primary mandate is to conduct induction and in-service training for State Forest Service Officers / Forest Range Officers and also to support in-service training for Forest Frontline Staff including Deputy Rangers, Foresters and Forest Guards. The Directorate plays a crucial role in keeping the forest management of our country upto date and modern through ever evolving modules and syllabus training.

The Government of India through this Directorate supplements the efforts of State Governments for capacity building of the Frontline Forest Staff including Deputy Rangers, Foresters and Forest Guards by providing funds to organise one week shortterm training courses for the concerned State Forest Department. This Directorate has got such courses organised in almost every State of the country and there has been wide spread appreciation of the same.

The Director's Report 2022-2023 of the Directorate of Forest Education is a compilation of all the activities of the Directorate and its constituent Academies during the year.

DIRECTORATE OF FOREST EDUCATION (DFE)

The Directorate of Forest Education was established in the year 1945 and was responsible for professional and technical trainings and education in the country. Subsequent to re-organization of forestry research, education and training institutions in 1987, the erstwhile Indian Forest College got upgraded to Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy. Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education was created as an autonomous body under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) to organize, direct and manage research in forest sector at national level.


The Directorate of Forest Education is an independent organization under the direct control of MoEF&CC for the training of State Forest Service (SFS) officers and Forest Range

Officers (FRO). The Directorate of Forest Education has been brought under the administrative control of Director, IGNFA w.e.f. 01.03.2022. The Directorate also supplements the efforts of the state governments for the training of Frontline Forest Staff including Deputy Rangers, Foresters and Forest Guards.

Mandate of the DFE are:

- To cater to the training needs of the SFS Officers and RFOs of States and Union Territories in the country.
- To ensure standard and quality of training being imparted to the forestry personnel other than Indian Forest Service.
- To augment training capacity and facility for the Frontline Forest Staff (Forest Guards, Foresters, Deputy Rangers and Range Officers).

- To assist in developing appropriate and relevant training contents and evaluation standards for forestry training at all levels below IFS.
- To help States assess training needs of forestry personnel.
- To assist in the development of training policy for forestry personnel.

Presently the Directorate has administrative and technical control over three Central Academies for State Forest Service, at Dehradun (Uttarakhand), Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) and Burnihat (Assam) and one Central Academy of Forest Education (CAFE) at Kurseong (West Bengal).

The Directorate also exercises, technical control over all the State run Rangers colleges / academies in the country. All these academies, colleges, institutes and schools undertake the activities concerning induction and in-service training of SFS officers and FROs and short term general refresher courses, theme based courses of one week duration for in-service SFS officers and FROs as per their respective mandate.

The Directorate of Forest Education is headed by the Director Forest Education; a senior officer from the Indian Forest Service. The Directorate has had illustrious members of the service heading it over a period of eight decades.

Rationalization / re-organization of administrative control of Forestry Training Academies of MoEF&CC under Director, IGNFA

With a view to enhance capacity building, efficiency in performance and economy, MoEF&CC vide letter dt. 03.02.2022 conveyed approval of the proposal for integration / unification of administrative control of forestry training academies. As per this order, administrative control of forestry training academies (IGNFA, 03 CASFOS at Dehradun, Burnihat and Coimbatore, and the CAFE, Kurseong) was brought under Director, IGNFA. The administrative control of DFE over CASFOS / CAFE to remain unaffected. Consequent to above order and as per directions of Director, IGNFA, actions have been taken to give effect to the integration order such as routine file approval process and combined reporting of IGNFA and DFE, rationalization of manpower of all academies, infrastructure sharing of IGNFA and CASFOS after integration, modification of process seeking approval of major works, integration / collaboration of e-Library facility at all academies. joint trainings of scientist and technical officers of Ministry, mutual facilitation of working plan and jungle survival modules of IFS Officers by CASFOS, Coimbatore, extension of IGNFA guidelines for engagement of consultants in CASFOS, revision of academic council for SFS training under proposed draft rules, plan of action for CAFE, Kurseong, regular review etc. All proposals for capital infrastructure improvement of DFE which are within the financial powers of Director, IGNFA are now approved at his level.

INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE DIRECTORATE

Following the re-organization of Forest Research Institute and Colleges and creation of Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE) as an autonomous organization, the Directorate of Forest Education was de-linked from the Forest Research Institute and Colleges. It has since then functioned directly under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.

To cater to the increasing demand of the state forest departments and central forestry organization for trained officers, three State Forest Service colleges were established by the Central Government at Burhihat (Assam) in 1976, Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) in 1980 and Dehradun (Uttarakhand) in 1981 for imparting training to the State Forest Service officers of two years duration.

The academies impart professional induction training to newly recruited State Forest Service officers and Forest Range Officers from various states, and offers in-service training to the State Forest Service officers of DCF, ACF, FRO and Deputy FRO ranks.

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Burnihat, Assam

Established in the year 1976, CASFOS, Burnihat has the distinction of being the first Academy for SFS / ACF officers in the country. The Academy is spread in an area of about 23 hectares with offices and most infrastructure facilities located in the Assam side of campus. However residential quarters for staff and officers are located in the Meghalaya side where NH 40 divides the Academy land into two. This Academy had provided induction training to 568 ACF/SFS officers in 18 batches. The Academy started training for FROs from the year 2000 and since then 518 Range Officers in 19 batches have passed out from this Academy as on date.

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu

Established in 1980, CASFOS, Coimbatore is located in the picturesque forest campus at R.S. Puram in the city of Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu. The academy is spread in an area of about 20 ha situated at a distance of 5 km from the

Coimbatore railway station and 22 km from Coimbatore international airport. The academy shares the space of the exquisite forest campus alongwith two more premier forestry institutions *viz.*, Tamil Nadu Forest Academy (TNFA) and Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB), one of the leading research institutes under Indian Council of Forest Research and Education. This campus also houses the famous 'Gass Museum'. Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology and National History (SACON) is another neighboring institution situated at a distance of 25 kms.

Since 1980, academy has provided induction training to 919 SFS officers in 27 batches. The

Academy started training for FROs from the year 2000 and since then 405 Range Officers in 14 batches have passed out from this academy as on date.

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Dehradun, Uttarakhand

Established in 1981, the CASFOS, Dehradun is located in the beautiful new forest campus in Dehradun which is also the cradle of forestry education and training in India. The academy is spread in an area of about 16 ha. The academy has the privilege of having in its neighbourhood in the new forest campus, other premier institutions like Indira Gandhi National Forest Acad-

emy (IGNFA), Indian Council for Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Forest Research Institute (FRI), FRI University, Forest Survey of India (FSI), Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Botanical Survey of India (BSI) and Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) which enhance the learning environment for the officer trainees with increased opportunities for interaction with serving many IFS officers, Probationers from IGNFA, Scientists and Researchers from ICFRE and FRI.

Academy has provided induction training to 1208 SFS officers in 34 batches. The academy has trained one batch of Forest Range officers also in the year 2006-2007, 37 FROs have passed out from this academy on that batch.

Central Academy of Forest Education (CAFE), Kurseong, West Bengal

Established in 1974, the CAFE is the only forest training institution under Government of India

exclusively to train Forest Range Officers. The academy is housed in a huge colonial period building and situated on picturesque Saint Mary's Hill in Kurseong sub-division of Darjeeling district, West Bengal. The academy building has three storey with basement and attic. The floor area of the building is 0.55 ha. The building has 121 rooms which houses office, principal's and faculty chambers, classrooms, conference room, engineering hall, library, hostel, mess, kitchen, bathrooms etc. The land area of the institute is about 12 ha, in which type - IV two quarters, type - III two quarters, type - I one quarter, one glass house, one football ground, one basketball court, one tennis court and one badminton court are also present besides the main academy building.

Academy has provided induction training to 1621 Forest Range Officers in 28 batches had passed out from this academy as on date.

Chandrapur Forest Academy of Administration, Development & Management (CFAAD&M), Chandrapur, Maharashtra

In the year 2014, the forest department of Government of Maharashtra has decided to upgrade the standard and to develop Forest Training Institute, Chandrapur into state forest academy. Purpose is not only to conduct inservice training to forest officers but through this Academy, to develop skilled manpower which is very much needed for the smooth management of forest property of the Maharashtra state. Keeping this vision, Chandrapur forest academy has planned with extended goal and purposes as compared to other forest academies in state and in other states of India.

Chandrapur Forest Academy's development work completed rapidly. Magnificent building of international standards and infrastructure facilities are developed. Advanced infrastructure facilities which are required for a training academy with residential facilities for trainees are also developed. With this, using latest information and technology, updated auditorium is also developed. Magnificence of this building speaks itself about the amplification of Forest Academy. The state of Maharashtra has determined a complex function, purpose and goal for Chandrapur Forest Academy. The State of Maharashtra does not limit the scope of Chandrapur Forest Academy to training for its forest officers but also, given the mandates like educational, research and development, publicity, safety and conservation of wildlife.

Himachal Pradesh Forest Academy (HPFA), Sundernagar, Himachal Pradesh

The erstwhile Forestry Training Institute and Rangers College (FTI&RC), Sundernagar, Himachal Pradesh, has been upgraded to Himachal Pradesh Forest Academy (HPFA), conducts induction training of Range Forest Officers, Forest Guards and refresher courses to in-service forest personnel. The institute started training Forest Guards in 1994. In the year 2012, the institute was empanelled for conducting 18 months certificate course for Range Forest Officers through DFE, Dehradun and six (06) batches comprising of 210 RFOs have passed out since than. Besides the regular training courses, tailor made refresher training courses on forestry and wildlife related subjects for serving forest frontline staff, ministerial staff and officers of different rank are conducted.

HPFA, Sundernagar is situated at an altitude of about 1000 meters above the mean sea level near Van Chetana Kendra DPF Trambari Karnody. It covers an area of 1.2 ha and is about 6 kms from Sundernagar bus stand on National Highway-21 (Chandigarh-Manali Highway).

Gujarat Forest Rangers College (GFRC), Rajpipla, Gujarat

Gujarat Forest Rangers College has been established in 1979 with an objective of training Range Forest Officers from different states of the country. This college is in a campus known as Vadia Palace presently in Rajpipla, dist. Narmada, Gujarat. The palace was built by the then King of Rajpipla Late Shri Vijaysinhji Gohil. After independence, this property was sold to Govt. of Bombay, which subsequently became Govt. of Gujarat after 1960. The total area of this campus is 56.08 ha. The first batch of Range Forest Officer trainees underwent the basic training during 1979-81 with strength of 31 trainees and subsequent batches after till then 608 Range Forest Officers took training in 18 batches. The college has trained OTs from a total of 12 states and 3 union territory. The alumni of this college are spread over Uttar Pradesh, Nagaland, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and UT of Diu and Daman, Dadra Nagar Haveli and Jammu & Kashmir.

The college also has imparted training to 341 *Vanpal Sahayak* (Forester Assistant) and 465 *Vanraksha Sahayak* (Guard Assistant) so far. The college also had conducted short and long term courses and front line staff training. The college has also conducted periodical trainings for surveyors, clerks and accountants of the department.

The college also has different facilities in form of classrooms, conference room, library, computer lab, sports ground, hostel and guesthouse. The college is also having facility of virtual class rooms through video conferencing for connecting with experts in different fields to interact with trainees on various occasions. Training in the field of weapons, swimming, motor mechanics and first aid have also been imparted.

Faculties for training have been selected from among serving and retired senior forest officers as well as from selected institutions such as MS University, Baroda and Navsari Agriculture University, Din Dayal Land and Survey Institute Gandinagar etc.

Karnataka Forest Academy (KFA), Dharwad, Karnataka

The erstwhile Forest Training Institute, Dharwad, established in 1996, has been upgraded to Karnataka Forest Academy (KFA), Dharwad. The construction of the Institute started in 1992 under World Bank aided social forestry project and was completed in 1996 under western ghats project. It was established as a Forest Training Institute in the year 1996 with the aim to provide in-service training to officers of Karnataka Forest Department and induction training to newly recruited staff. Located at a distance of 12 km from district head quarters Dharwad, the campus is spread over an area of 42.16 ha. In January 2015, Government of India approved the proposal for setting up RFO academy at FTI, Gungargatti, Dharwad and it was upgraded to the status of forest academy and renamed Karnataka Forest Academy, Dharwad and it received accreditation and recognition by the DFE as one of the training institutions in the country for imparting forestry training to Forest Range Officers.

Kundal Academy of Development, Administration and Management (KADAM), (Forests), Kundal, Maharashtra

KADAM (Forests), Kundal, Maharashtra is one of the premiere institute in the country which imparts the training to various cadres of the forest department and other government departments. Initially it was started as forest training institute on 15.08.2013 vide Government of Maharashtra, Revenue and Forest Department Government resolution dated 24.06.2011.

The academy was given autonomous status by the Government of Maharashtra Revenue Forest Department Resolution dated 07.02.2014. The State Forestry Training Society has been formed and is registered under Mumbai charitable trust Act 1950 and Society Registration Act, 1860.

The academy has administration building, training institute, mess and gym building, executive hostel, boys and ladies hostel. The

academy has eight classrooms which have the seating capacity of 552 and 3 computer labs with 136 capacity. There are six hostels in which 300 trainees can be accommodated. Recently the grants for construction of separate executive hostel with 175 capacity was received and the work is in progress.

The academy is well equipped with cardiac gym, regular exercises gym and separate ladies gym. There is good playing facilities like badminton court, snooker, table tennis, lawn tennis court. 50 bicycles are made available for the trainees which acts as a source of recreation and exercise for all the trainees trained here.

The campus is well protected and security is maintained. The lust green garden lawns Sahyadri biological Park, Bamboo setum, Miyawaki plantations are some of the landmarks that glorify the campus.

Odisha Forest Rangers College (OFRC), Angul, Odisha

OFRC, Angul has been established in the year 1979 in Angul district of Odisha to impart training to the newly recruited Forest Rangers of Odisha and other states like Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Andaman & Nicobar Island, Assam, Mizoram, Arunachala Pradesh and Nagaland. This is the premier forest training institute situated in the heart of Odisha with proximity to deep forests, wildlife sanctuaries and a tiger reserve which helps to impart classroom training and exposure visits simultaneously to the trainees. The state run college is controlled by the Director Forest Education, Dehradun in respect of all matters related to the courses and imparting training to the trainees. Total 583 Forest Ranger trainees have been trained in 17 batches from this institution from 1979 to till date.

Tamil Nadu Forest Academy (TNFA), Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu

Having evolved from the erstwhile Madras Forest College at Coimbatore which has a glorious history of over 109 years, the Tamil Nadu Forest Academy has grown and reckoned as one of the premier institutions of the country conducting in-service and induction training for forest personnel from forest watchers to IFS officers; Over the last 10 years of its existence, the academy has moulded and equipped many batches of forest officials with professional knowledge and skills required for them to discharge their duties as professional foresters.

The induction training in TNFA, was conducted only in 1998-2000 for mere 7 trainees. In 2015, the state government recruited 76 candidates as FROs and approached DFE for their training. However, the then Senior officers, Principal Secretary and Honorable Minister thought that induction training in TNFA, Coimbatore should be revived. Immediately the Government of India, MoEF&CC was moved suitably and the accreditation for conducting the FRO induction training was obtained in Jan, 2015. Since 2015, 305 trainees in 8 batches had passed out from the Academy.

Telangana State Forest Academy (TSFA), Hyderabad, Telangana

TSFA was established at Dulapally in the year 2000. It organizes various in-campus, offcampus, Government of India sponsored training for forest officials at various level. The training is also under taken for forest related activities for the staff of other departments. Since 2010 FRO training has started.

Uttarakhand Forestry Training Academy (UFTA), Haldwani, Uttarakhand

UFTA is one of the premier institutions under Uttarakhand Forest Department, with a distinction of imparting wide array of training to wide spectrum of candidates. It was established in 1978 as a part of Uttar Pradesh Forest Department.

Since its inception, UFTA has accomplished milestones of enormous magnitude and is ranked amongst the top forestry training institutes of India. Under the administration and management of Uttarakhand Forest Department, the UFTA imparts induction training to Range Officers, Foresters and Forest Guards. It also offers quarterly courses to frontline staff and forest corporation employees. It is ideally located at Haldwani, Nainital (Uttarakhand) which has train and bus connectivity to other parts of country.

The institute has outstanding and sprawling infrastructure with large administrative and academic block, guest houses and hostels for boys and girl's trainees, mess, library, playground, interpretation centre, gymnasium and auditorium etc. The library of UFTA has possessed big asset with an extensive collection of books. The administrative and teaching staffs resides in the campus itself, offering student a robust and sound technical and academic support round the clock. The UFTA administration ensures the availability of high and sophisticated gadgets for the training purpose so that the students are accustomed to prevalent use of technologies in their fields.

INDUCTION TRAINING OF STATE FOREST SERVICE OFFICERS

The main mandate of the Directorate is the two years induction training for the newly recruited SFS officers. The syllabi includes class room sessions, practical, field exercises, qualifying modules, case study tours, extensive zonal tours and a four month On Job Training (OJT). The training includes a first phase of training for 16 months in the academy followed by a four month long OJT in the respective states and finally the advanced phase for four months at the academy. During their stay at the academy, the trainees also undergo rigorous physical endurance training and are exposed to various cultural, literary and social service activities for their all round personality development.

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Burnihat (Assam)

2022-2024 SFS Batch: A batch with strength of 48 SFS officer trainees from Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh commenced the two years induction course on 05.12.2022.

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu)

2020-2022 SFS Batch: A batch with strength of

43 SFS officer trainees from Chhattisgarh, Jammu and Kashmir, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh completed the two years induction course on 22.11.2022.

2022-2024(I) SFS Batch: A batch with strength of 53 SFS officer trainees from Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh commenced the two years induction course on 11.04.2022.

2022-2024(II) SFS Batch: A batch with strength of 53 SFS officer trainees from Karnataka and Rajasthan commenced the two years induction course on 28.11.2022.

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Dehradun (Uttarakhand)

2021-2023 SFS Batch: A batch with strength of 33 SFS officer trainees from Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Maharashtra commenced the two years induction course on 02.08.2021.

2022-2024 SFS Batch: A batch with strength of 70 SFS officer trainees from Uttar Pradesh, Odisha, Bihar, Maharashtra, Tripura, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand commenced the two years induction course on 18.07.2022.

INDUCTION TRAINING OF FOREST RANGE OFFICERS

The Directorate also conducts and monitors 18 months induction training for the newly recruited FROs. The syllabi include classroom sessions, practicals, field exercises, qualifying modules and extensive tours.



IN-SERVICE TRAININGS

General Refresher Course

The general refresher course is designed in a way to refresh the professional skills of the inservice officers and also to help them keep abreast of the sector at all levels, including regional, national and international issues like protected area management, bio-diversity conservation, global warming etc. in forestry and related disciplines. This one week course is organized for promoted officers of SFS and FRO cadres.

Legal Issues in Forestry and Wildlife

The ever increasing population is bringing pressure on space and resources of mega-cities. The smaller towns have also started feeling the pinch. The forest, its resources and wildlife are no exception to this phenomenon. Often, violation of various provisions of acts, rules and regulations governing forest, protected areas, wildlife, etc. are seen and they are showing an increasing trend. Apart from prevention and early detection of various forest and wildlife offences, it is also imperative to achieve the maximum penalty on the offenders. Ultimately, effective prosecution of offenses in present and as in the past, is the biggest deterrent for future offenders. This scenario is throwing open a challenge before the personnel manning the forests and wildlife to upgrade and update their legal knowledge and acumen. These aspects including knowledge, skills and right interpretation of extant acts, rules and procedures have been kept in view while preparing this course.

Training of Trainers

There is an ever-emerging challenge of capacity building of the trainers who join the state forest training institutes from organization postings. It is proposed to respond to this need of training of trainers with a systematic approach to training which has been spearheaded by the Department of Personnel and Training of the Government of India, for more than two decades now. The success of training depends upon identification of training needs to make it demanddriven, scientifically design suitable demands of change, deliver effectively with learner centered approach and monitor/evaluate for further value addition. In addition mentoring and facilitation has become an integral part of functioning. All these aspects and latest trends in training have been kept in view while preparing this course.

Human Resource Management

For achieving effective management of the forest resources one of the important issues to be analyzed is existing human resource capabilities and how to build upon them. The performance in forest departments of the states depends on the collective contributions of all the officers / officials. The approach for capacity building of the forestry personnel for protection, conservation and sustainable management of forest resources, using appropriate technology at the same time developing an attitude of working with the stakeholders, is required to be institutionalized. It involves judicious use of authority and keeping the workforce motivated for the effective management of resources.

Wildlife Management


The ever increasing human population is mounting pressure on natural resources including forest and wildlife since long. It is of paramount importance to conserve and sustain the wildlife for the existence of mankind. Though it is very difficult to envisage co-existence of man and animal in present socio-economic human controlled environment, but the exclusive domain of wildlife can be maintained in these natural ecosystems.

Biodiversity Conservation for Sustainable Livelihood

The importance of the social dimension of forestry in today's world need not be overtly emphasized. With human population exploding across the globe, the pressure on forests for meeting the needs of fuel wood, fodder, timber has proportionately expanded. The stresses on natural ecosystems due to anthropogenic pressure have assumed dimensions of war not struggle for survival for the natural ecosystems and its myriad inhabitants. A recognition of the human dimension of forestry led to the implementation of Social and community forestry programmes in the 1970s and 1980s. A further recognition of the people's rights on forests and their role in forestry came in the form of Joint Forest Management (JFM) resolution in 1991.

Training of Frontline Staff at SFTIs

Government of India supplements the efforts of State Governments for capacity building of the frontline staff (Deputy Rangers / Foresters / Forest Guards) by providing funds to organize short-term training courses of one week duration each, for a group of 25 participants of the concerned State Forest Department where the course is organized. The State Forest Department provides the infrastructure facilities (*e.g.* lecture hall, hostel accommodation etc.) and the resource persons to organize these courses. The total duration of the course should be for 6 days (4 sessions / day), out of which 1 day may be devoted to field tours / excursions exercise. A total of ₹ 3,81,324/- was provided as assistance to various States for conducting of 12 courses benefitting 302 frontline staff of six states.
