1.	Q.1. Kindly give details of the budgetary allocation announced for the year 2021-22 along with the budgetary allocation requested for the year 2021-22 by the Ministry.	Announced: Rs.14.50 + Rs.10.00(Capital) Requested: Rs.17.08 + Rs.10.00(Capital)
2.	Q.2. How will the key programmes/ schemes/ projects of the Ministry be impacted if there is a sustainable difference between the budgetary and actual allocation requested by the Ministry in the budget 2021-22? What is the strategy of the ministry in dealing with the challenges arising out of these differences?	The short term training programmes/ theme based courses by the Directorate and its constituent Academies are being conducted through online platform instead of offline classes which has reduced the expenditure thereof. Also, the funds for short term training programmes conducted at the SFTIs shall be provided to the States for conducting such courses through online platform instead of offline classes. The number of such trainings will be reduced.
3.	Q.3. Kindly provide details of the absolute bare minimum increased needed in the budgetary allocation for the year 2021-22 to sustain key programmes with the desired outcomes and efficiency.	Funds shall be required in the subhead OC and OCS for conducting short term courses for frontline staff, as most of the SFTIs are unable to conduct these courses due to unavailability of infrastructure for online classes

4.	Q.4. What was the impact of COVID-19 on the budgetary allocation of the Ministry during 2020-21? How are the schemes/ programmes of the Ministry impacted?	This Directorate imparts Induction training to the State Forest Service Officer and Forest Range Officers through its constituent Academies. Besides this, short term theme-based training programs are also conducted for in-service SFS and FROs. During the ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, most of the training activities have been conducted through online platform. Various guidelines and SOPs from Govt. of India are being followed while conducting the training activities.
5.	Q.20. An amount of Rs.179 crore has been allocated for North Eastern areas in 2021 22. How do the Ministry propose to utilise the allocated among? Please give details.	N.A.


