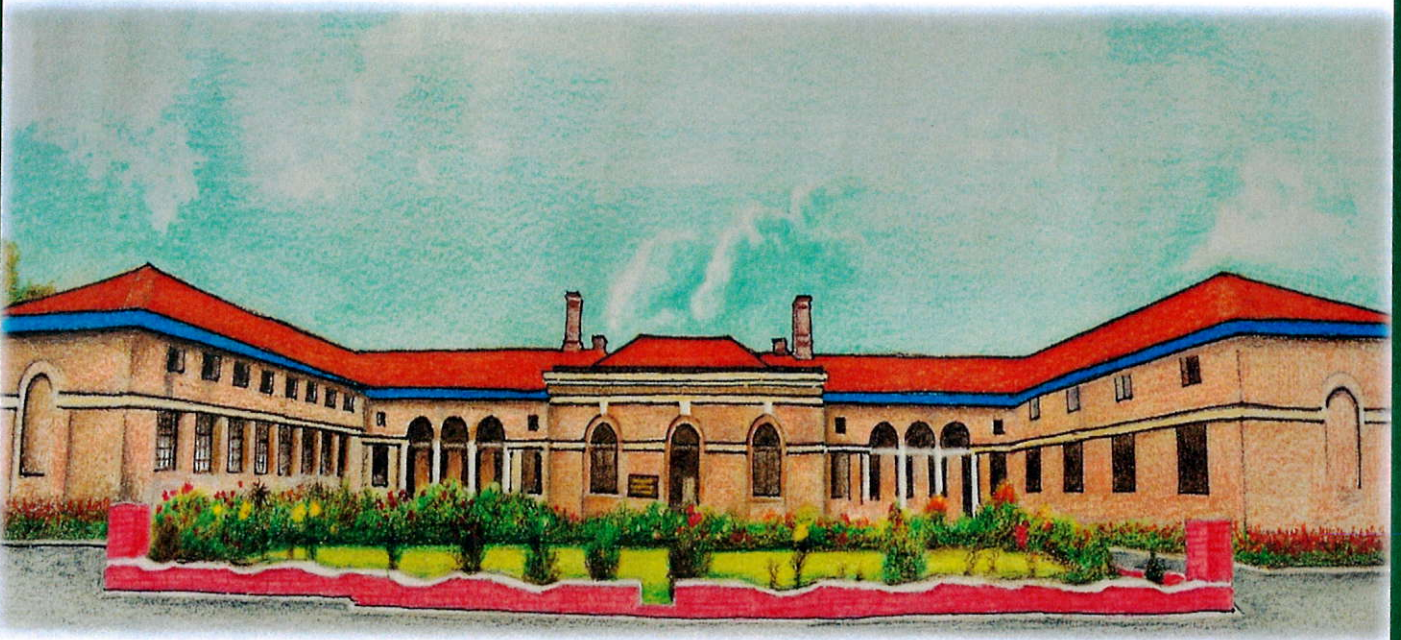

Executive Summary

Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India is mandated with conducting short term training courses for personnel of other departments with an objective to foster enhanced co-operation and convergence between various departments to achieve the goals of conservation. Accordingly, a two-days online course on **‘Role of Judiciary in Forest and Wildlife’** for *Judges and Magistrates of District & Subordinate Courts* was held from 09th to 10th February, 2022. Keeping in view the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic situation, the course was conducted on an online mode using Microsoft Teams video conferencing application. A total number of 122 participants registered from 19 States/Union Territories for the training. However, 117 participants who had more than 75 percent attendance in the course were awarded Course Completion Certificates. The participants included sitting Judges & Magistrate, Faculty of Judicial Academies and few Judicial Probationary Trainee Officers also. The Course was designed to sensitize the Judicial Officers of the District & Subordinate Courts on topics related to Forestry, Wildlife and Biodiversity conservation in India.

The training was inaugurated by Hon’ble Justice Swatanter Kumar, Former Judge, Supreme Court of India and Former Chairperson, National Green Tribunal as the Chief Guest. In his inaugural address, the Chief Guest spoke about the concepts of Judicial activism, Judicial creativity & Judicial outreach. As he laid emphasis on impacts of deforestation, he also spoke about the importance of Precautionary Principle in forest and wildlife conservation. He also opined that environmental consciousness is more important than knowledge of environment laws. The Chief Guest concluded this address by appreciating the need for such courses to sensitize not only the Judicial Officers but also various Others Stakeholders. Experienced resource persons delivered sessions on topics like Forest and Wildlife Conservation in India: Overview of Forest related Policy and Laws in India, Issues and challenges in Forest and Wildlife Jurisprudence, Biological Diversity Act-2002, Insight into Wildlife related offence, Insight into Wildlife (Protection) Act-1972 and Judicial Activism in Forestry and Wildlife. Details of resource persons and schedule are enclosed as Appendices III and V in this report.

Valedictory session was presided over by Ms. Nidhi Srivastava, IFS, Principal, CASFOS, Dehradun during which an interactive session with the participants was also held. The participants expressed the need to conduct more such courses so that the delicate matter pertaining to Forest & Wildlife jurisprudence can be handled by Officers of the Judiciary. The participants gave overwhelming response to the course.

The soft copies of articles and write-ups related to the relevant topics covered during the course, apart from the copies of the presentations made by the experts and the recordings of each sessions were also provided to each participant as part of the training kit which was shared through Microsoft Share point and website.

Overall impact of the training was positive and the feedback and high rating from the participants corroborates the assessment of the organizers.

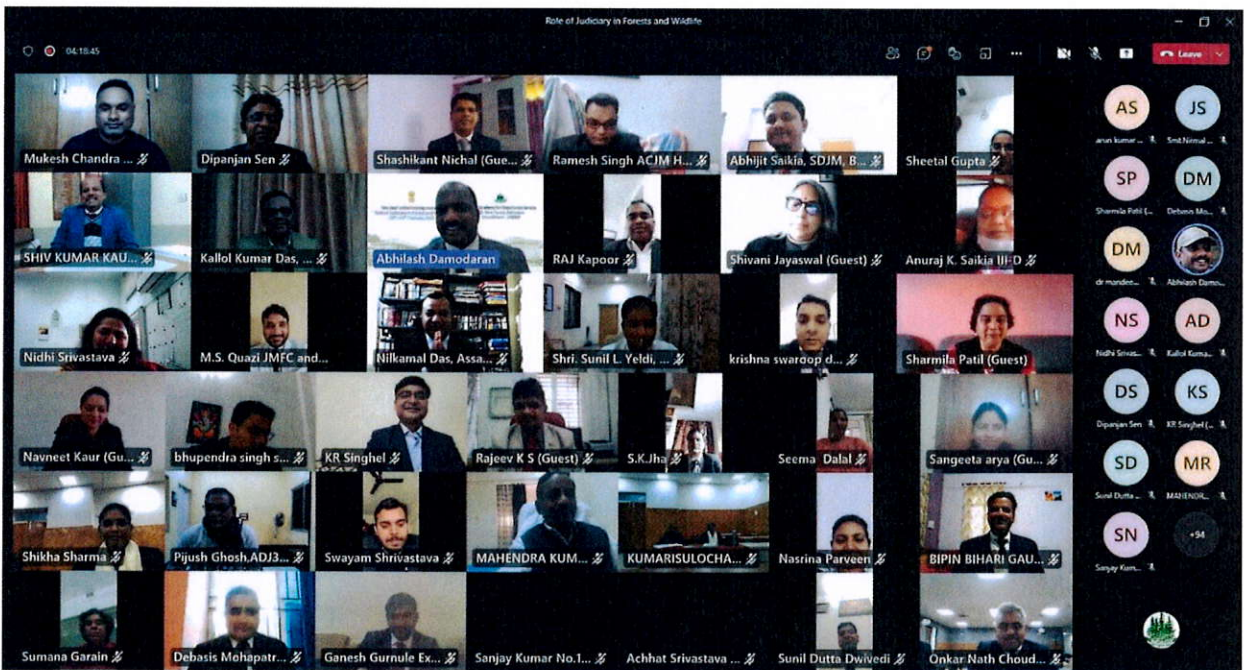

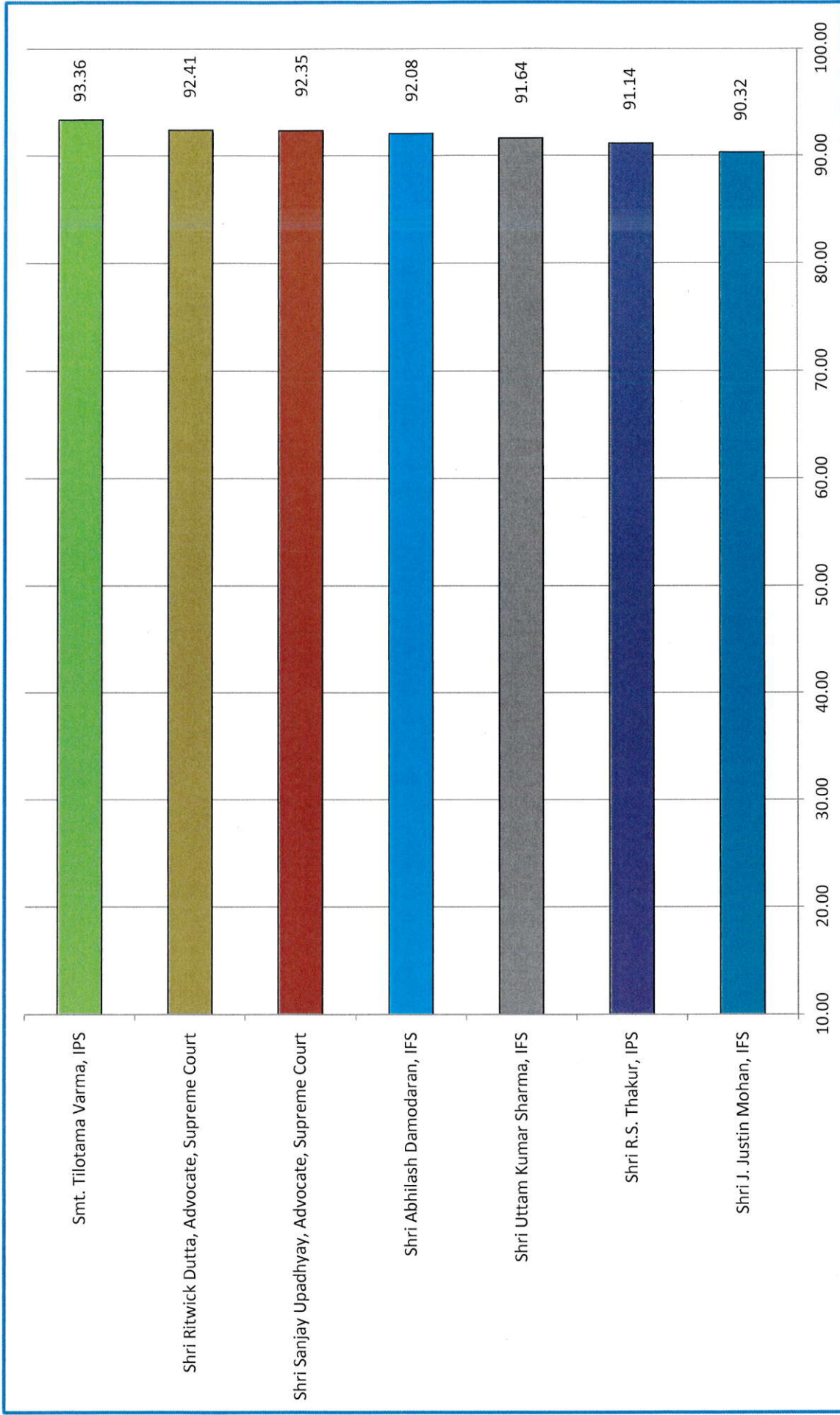

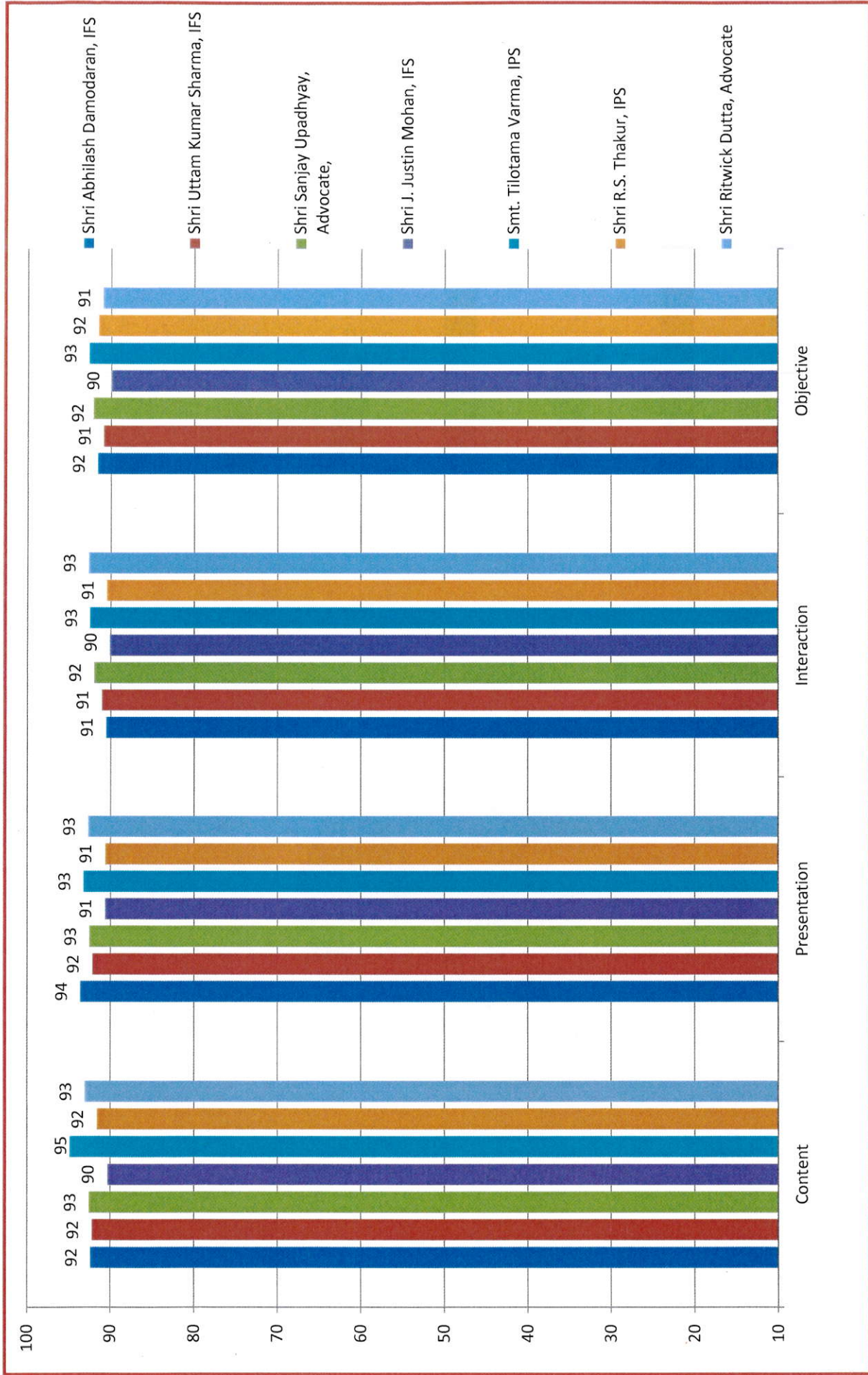

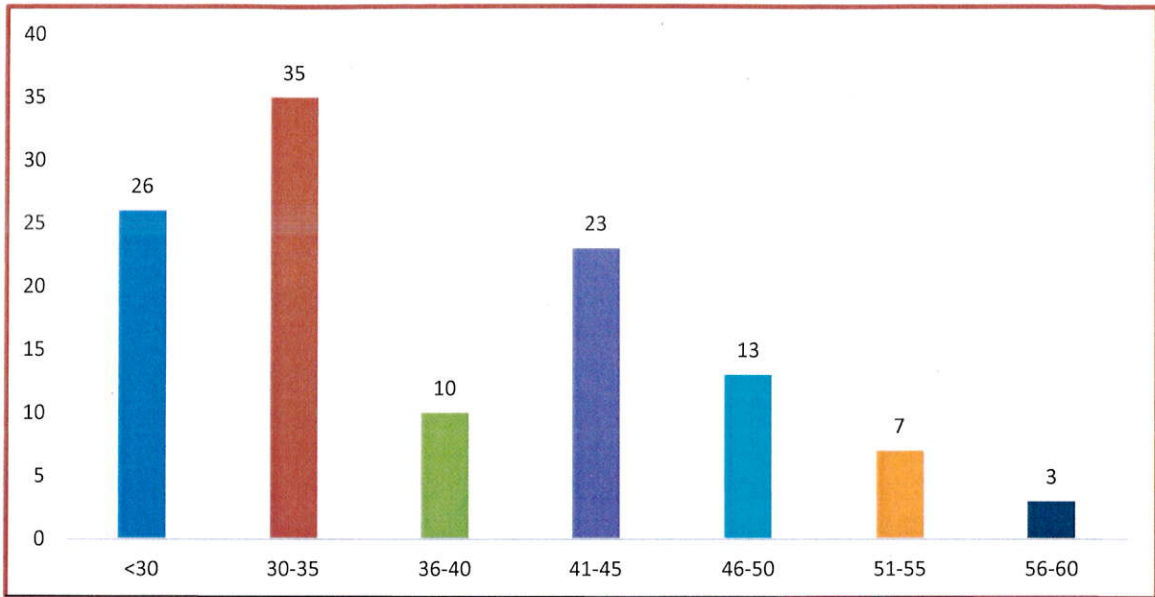

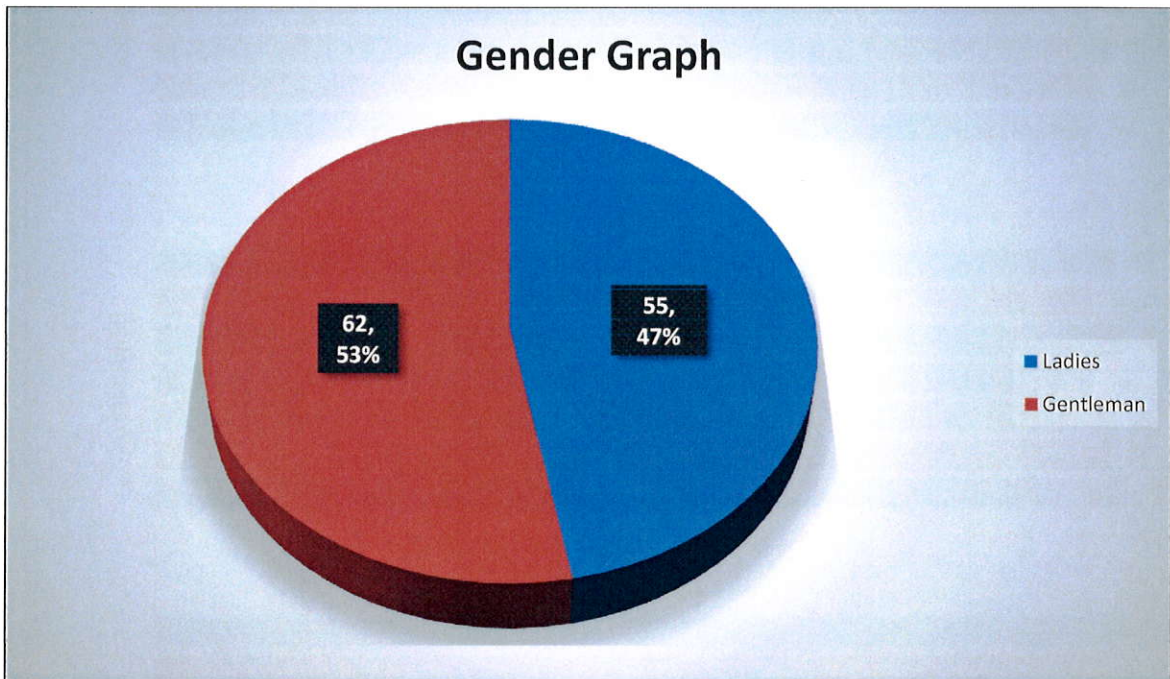
Overall Feedback of Resource Persons on all Parameters
