

Course detail-cum-Feedback Report

Subject: Course detail-cum-Feedback Report regarding Five days training for frontline Staff (Dy. Rangers/Foresters/Forest Gaurds) on Forest Fire Prevention and Mitigation strategies.

Five days training course on "Forest Fire Prevention and Mitigation strategies" for frontline Staff of HP Forest Department has been conducted w.e.f. 04-12-2023 to 08-12-2023 at Himachal Pradesh Forest Academy, Sundernagar. In this course 20 trainees participated from different Forest Circles. (Detail List Enclosed).

The training course was sponsored by the Director of Forest Education, Dehradun, GoI. The course content as prescribed by DFE, Dehradun is followed for the training purpose and is attached herewith.

On the last day of training a separate feedback session regarding the said course was conducted and **verbal as well as written** feedback from participants was collected in order to assess overall reaction, strengths, area of improvements and suggestion of participants. This session was presided over by worthy Anil Saxena, Retd IFS, Ex.Pr.CCF AGMUT cadre who was on visit to HPFA, Sundernagar as onsite assessor on behalf of NABET, Quality Council of India. In this session, trainees interacted with the worthy Anil Saxena, Retd IFS as well as faculty members regarding the said course. From trainee's feed back some important suggestions have came to the fore for further improving the course module which is as under:

1. **Strong points of the course:** Most of the trainees appreciated the usefulness wrt Theoretical and Practical aspects of training. The training updated their knowledge and information.
 - Trainees appreciated most of the theoretical sessions. Senior officers Sh. Pradeep Thakur, IFS Director-cum-Addl.PrCCF delivered three sessions and Sh. Anil Sharma, IFS, CCF Bilaspur also delivered 2 sessions.
 - Hands on training on map reading and GPS.
 - Fire control demonstration, mock drill exercises, control burning exercise, First Aid (CPR) are very relevant and effective.
 - Apps and technologies on Forest fire management and demonstration.
2. **Suggestions about the course/training:** Most of the trainees were satisfied with the training. Suggestions about duration of the course were received, few trainees have suggested to increase and few trainees suggested to decrease the duration of the course. In undersigned opinion the duration course is enough as the course was very specific.



The feedback received from the participants highlights the strong points of the course as well as the scope of the improvement in this course. In term of overall organization of the course majority of the trainees have found course informative well structured and well coordinated keeping in view the content and course duration. It is further submitted that the feedback given by participants will be used to further refine the training/course to ensure an even more effective learning experience. Report is submitted for your kind consideration and further guidance in this regard.

Recommendations:

1. Keeping in view of the theoretical and practical aspects of the training, the five days sessions are appropriate and sufficient.
2. Strength of the course required to be increased to 35-40, as it is an important aspect for protection and conservation of forests. *(At least one ^{F.L} staff from each Forest Division.)*
