Vigilance Awareness Week Organised with Series of Programs at ICAR-IISWC, Dehradun and its Research Centres during October 26 to November 01, 2021

The ICAR-Indian Institute of Soil and Water Conservation (ICAR-IISWC) organised a full-fledged program with series of events on **Vigilance, Integrity, Good Governance and Self-Reliance during the Vigilance Awareness Week (VAW)**, 26th Oct to 1st Nov. 2021. The program begun with an integrity pledge to be honest and vigilant, on 26th Oct. 2021 at the main office of IISWC in Dehradun and its 8 other Regional Centres. The program ended with a webinar on Preventive Vigilance, Integrity, Good Governance and Self-Reliance” and “On matters related to purchasing procedures” on 1st Nov. 2021. While the whole Institute was engaged in the program of VAW, the webinar was attended by over 60 scientists, technical personnel and staff of the IISWC.

Dr M Madhu, Director, ICAR-IISWC in his concluding remarks emphasized to being in transparency and integrity in every walk of life, not just during the vigilance week alone so as to help build organisation and trust amongst the stakeholders and the public. He informed the participants that official irregularities and mismanagement of research outputs and outcomes sometimes becomes the issue of vigilance and amounts to corruption beyond the monitory realms, which every scientist and staff should be aware of.

Dr M Muruganandam, Principal Scientist, and Vigilance Officer, ICAR-IISWC spoke on the needs of the vigilance, sensitive areas of vigilance, scope of vigilance angle, manifestation of corruption and malfunctions, features of various vigilance programs including preventive and participatory vigilance and principles of good governance. He emphasized the justification for and means of killing corruption individually and collectively in order to make prosperous India.

The week-long program included quiz on vigilance, integrity, good governance, CCS (CCA) and administrative, store and purchase rules/procedures and debate competitions on “Is Integrity Responsible for Self-Reliance in India?” with the focus on this year Theme, “Independent India @ 75: Self-Reliance with Integrity”.

Dr Raman Jeet Singh, Sr Scientist, Dr Sadikul Islam, Scientist, Dr Sangeeta N Sharma, CTO, Er Amit Chauhan, STO, IISWC besides all the Divisions and Centres of the Institute have coordinated quiz, debate and various other programs on the vigilance and good governance.

As part of the week-long program, Dr Muruganandam sensitised 70 employees of the Brahmaputra Board, Government of India, on preventive vigilance and good governance through an online workshop organised by the Board, on Oct 27, 2021.

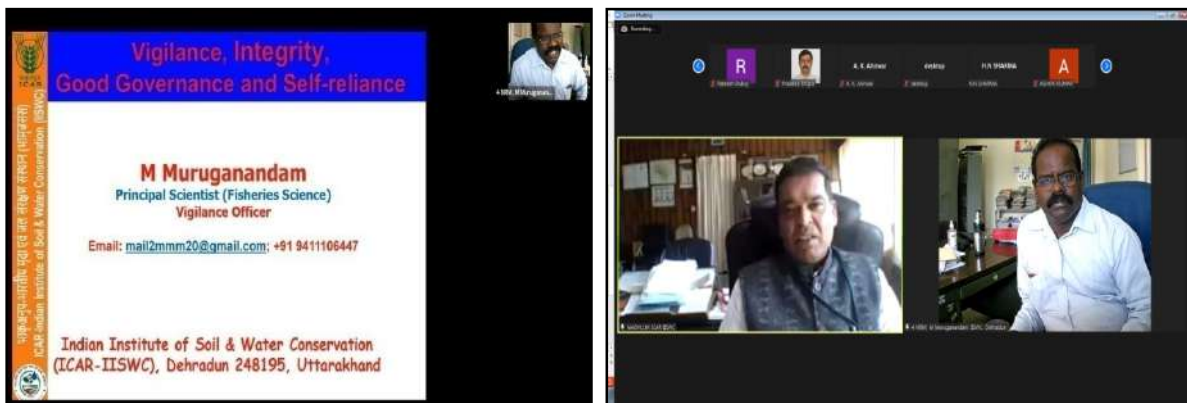

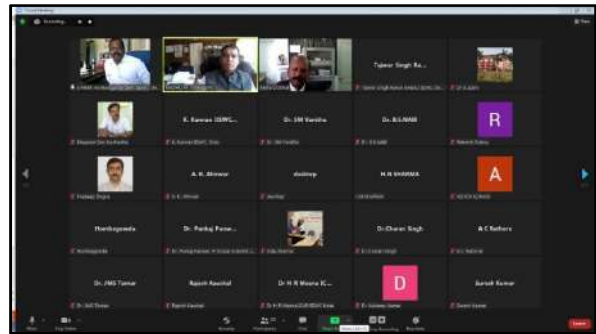

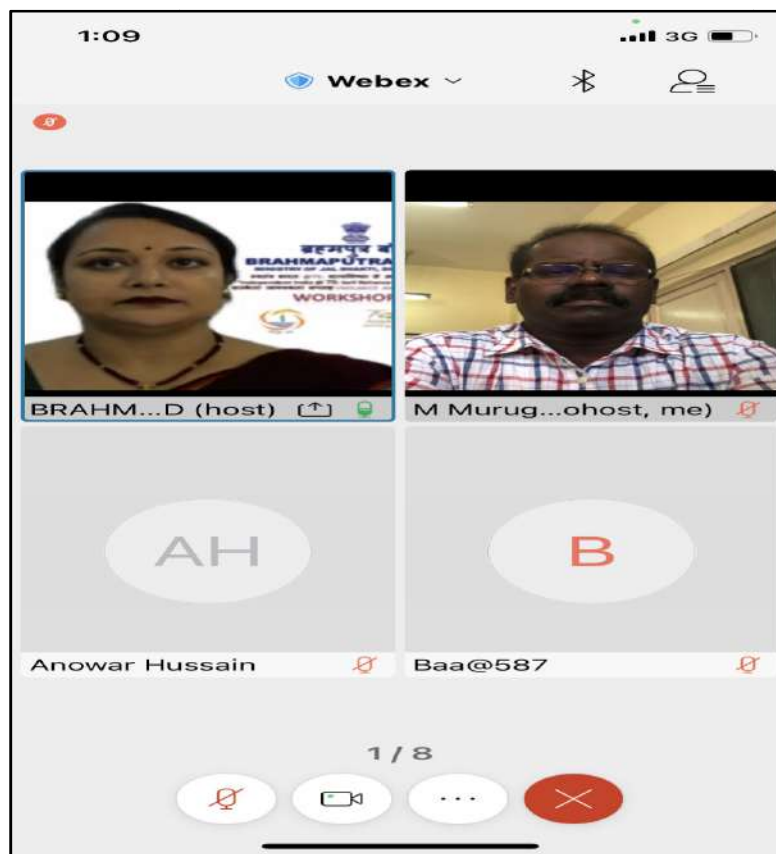
